- Everyone should have received an email with the SPF Results. We are a **green school** two years in the running. Student Engagement was scored high. On page 3 of the document, Language Art percentages did increase. Discussion on Student Achievement and overall SPF Results.
- Attendance has been a challenge over the whole school district; last year MCT ended at 62% and the district wants the school to increase that percentage to 67%.
- Title 1 - is a grant that supports students with high needs, funds are provided to students for free and reduced lunch population. Information was provided to parents in their packets during the parent teacher conference. Cover extensively the slides on the Title 1 Federal program. No questions or concerns from CSC committee
- PAC Meeting - an email was provided to all to review as Ms. Koger reviewed the document. There are over 200 different languages spoken in DPS. Students can earn a Seal of Biliteracy by taking the CLEP language test. At MCT students are able to take the CLEP to earn credit. We are a CLEP testing center, and currently the only CLEP testing center in the Far-Northeast. MCT offers MLE and ELD support/testing/information for students.
